Instructions for submitting information for the SLHC Award Certificate

- 1.) **Please print or write clearly.** (I will make every effort to deduce what has been written but if in the end I can't read it, then the Certificate will not be made.)
- 2.) **Submit one form per dog. *Deadline for Submission(s) is November 10, 2008.***
(Any titles earned after this date will be included in the 2009 Award Certificates.)
- 3.) **Submission can be made in person, through the mail, or on-line.**
(NOTE: I can only receive attachments 2 megabytes or less)

- 4.) **Please clearly identify the dog in the picture.** (If the dog in the picture is not clearly identified then the picture will *not* be included on the Certificate.)
- 5.) **Please clearly identify the owner of the picture(s), diskette(s) or CD(s) and include a return address.**
(If the owner is not clearly identified then I can't return them to their rightful owner(s).)
- 6.) **Please limit the number of photographs to 1 per dog per activity.**
(For example, if the dog has earned multiple titles in various activities, then submit one photo of the dog herding ducks or sheep or cattle, doing weave poles or teeter totter for agility, or going over the jumps while doing flyball. These are only examples but I think you get the idea.)
Hint: A photo of the dog being presented with the actual award for that activity is nice.

Instructions for submitting pictures for the SLHC Award Certificate

If submitting actual photographs of dogs:

Please choose pictures that focus clearly on the dog and the activity he/she is doing.

(To conserve space, I may have to "crop" the photographs to make them fit. This task will be easier if the photo focuses primarily on the dog. I will *not* physically cut the picture to make it fit. The cropping will be done using software after the photo is scanned in.)

Please limit the size of the photograph to 4 X 6.

If submitting scanned photos, digital photos on diskette or photos on CD:

Please choose pictures that focus clearly on the dog and the activity he/she is doing.

(To conserve space, please crop the photo to reduce the disk space necessary to store the photo. This will also cut down on the file size of the Certificate. I use Adobe PhotoShop as my OCR software. Please save the cropped photo as a jpeg file)

If you do not wish to crop your own photo, then save the photo as a .bmp file.
